CDBG funds are spent on projects and activities that primarily assist low and moderate-income persons.

Lexington County has allocated funding through its CDBG program to assist homeowners with the repair and/or replacement of a failing septic system. Homeowners that meet the CDBG income restrictions can apply to have their septic tank repaired at no cost.

Signs of a failing septic system:

- Ponding in your yard
- Wet, mushy ground
- Septic backing up in house

Proper septic tank maintenance:

- Conserve water to reduce stress on your tank
- Pump your tank regularly
- Don't flush coffee grounds, household chemicals and grease
