Time to clean out carports, garages, yard barns and storage sheds. Trim up trees, shrubs and hedges. Weed the flower beds. Rake yards and mow grass. Sweep driveways. Pick up trash, soda cans and cigarette butts along neighborhood streets. We can take pride in our homes and neighborhoods.



- ❑ Separate Clean-Up Day trash from regular household and yard waste. **Don't forget to recycle items when possible.**
- ❑ Place tires and car batteries away from household and yard trash. Limit four tires per household.
- ❑ Fill old paint cans with kitty litter, sand or dirt. Stack separately from household and yard trash.
- ❑ Separate electronics (computers, printers, TV's, etc.) from other household waste.
- ❑ For large appliances, furniture, or bulky items, please call the West Columbia Sanitation Department at 796-8006 to schedule collection.

Some Clean-Up Day items will be picked up on Saturday, April 26, 2014, but city sanitation trucks will pick up other Clean-Up Day trash on the regular collection days during the week of April 28 through May 2, 2014. An E-recycle truck will take electronic equipment such as computers, monitors, printers, laptops, microwaves and TVs with unbroken screens on Saturday, April 26, 2014 from 8 a.m. to Noon at the City Hall parking lot, located at 200 N. 12th Street in West Columbia.
