

Children 18 and younger may receive free lunch. Lunch is also available to persons with disabilities, over age 18, who participate in school programs for people who are mentally or physically disabled.

- Lunch is open on a first-come, first-served basis to all children of the community at large.
- Children must meet age requirements (see above) and be accompanied by an adult or guardian at all times.
- Adults may eat for \$3.65.
- Lunch must be consumed onsite.
- Cafeteria will be open for lunch only.
